CRITERIA FOR **THE FERRY STREET AND TURNER STREET APARTMENTS** **LONG-TERM TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM**

1. Families must have at least one eligible child under the age of 18 residing with the family.
2. Families must be eligible for 2-3 bedroom apartments.
3. Families must be homeless or near homeless at the time of application. Near-homeless is defined as per self-declaration or eviction notice.
4. Families must have a prearranged payment plan designed to repay outstanding debts to local housing authorities.
5. Families must meet Poverty Income Guidelines.
6. Families must be experiencing a situation where significant progress or resolve is possible within a two-year period.
7. Families must have a relationship with the referral agency prior to the application.
8. The applicant(s) must be enrolled or must be in the process to enroll and complete their education, training, or vocational program.
9. No active drug or alcohol users will be admitted to the program.
10. Past drug/alcohol abusers must be drug free for one year prior to application. Candidates requesting special consideration will be considered under certain circumstances at the time of application.
